**St John's Primary School - pushed County Council to speed up building of delayed £6m SEND facilities.**



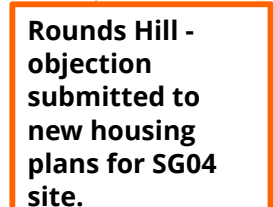
**Talisman Square - worked with residents and others to try to stop new apartments development.**
